

WOLF TRAX BORON DDP

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Mixing instructions for foliar application - Fill tank to 1/3 full, start agitation and pour package contents into tank. Use sufficient water to ensure thorough coverage. If mixing with a crop protection product, always add the micronutrient to the spray solution before adding the crop protection product. (Prior to spraying, conduct a compatibility test by adding the products to water in a litre jar to ensure that the products will remain in solution) It is also recommended to use 50 mesh or coarser screens on all nozzles.

Use instructions for drip irrigation - CAUTION: Micronutrients, regardless of manufacturer, require special care to ensure that they stay in suspension in drip irrigation systems. To minimize the risk of this, pre-slurry the Wolf Trax product by adding the product at a ratio of 1 kg per 200 L of the irrigation water to be used. Run agitation for 5 minutes prior to applying. If the product appears to precipitate out of solution, use an agriculturally approved pH adjuster to lower the pH of the water so that solubility is increased before injecting the solution. If mixing with other fertilizers, conduct a compatibility test by mixing them in 20 L of water. Use stainless steel pumps, and fittings and poly pipe. Use an anti-siphon/shut off valve to ensure that there is no danger of backflow into a water source. **RATE:** Use foliar rates of Boron DDP (see chart below).

Foliar application rates and timing – The following rates are based on correcting deficiencies seen in extensive field-testing. Individual rate recommendations may be obtained using a tissue test, and repeat applications may be necessary. **CAUTION** - The use of this product on crops other than those listed may result in serious injury to the crop.

Crop	Foliar Rate	Foliar Timing
Beets, carrots, cucumbers, lettuce, onions, turnips, radishes, spinach, broccoli, cabbage, celery, cauliflower, brussel sprouts, peppers, tomatoes, potatoes, lentils, peas, beans	300 g/ha	Apply 1 to 4 weeks after emergence. Normally a repeated treatment (maximum 3 treatments per season) is necessary to correct deficiency.
Maize, Oil Seed Rape, hops, sunflowers, cereals, sugar beet	300 g/ha	Apply before bloom or heading. If necessary to correct deficiency, this treatment may be repeated up to three times per season.
Apples, pears, cherries, plums, strawberries, cane berries, grapes	300 g/ha	Apply pre-bloom or post harvest while the leaves are green and still actively growing. If necessary to correct deficiency, this treatment may be repeated up to three times per season.
